

The Barnes County Commission met in regular session on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 with Cindy Schwehr, Vicky Lovell, Bill Carblom, Pete Paulson, and Shawn Olauson present. Chairman Carblom called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m., roll-call was taken, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the Agenda was reviewed.

Human Service Zone – Copier Request

Mandi Freije, Buffalo Bridges Human Service Zone Director, presented a proposal for copier replacement. Bill Carblom moved to approve purchase of a used copier and two scanners from Central Business Systems at a cost of \$4,407.48, plus a maintenance contract at \$26.88 per month; Vicky Lovell seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting “yes”.

Auditor – Minutes / Local Permit

Pete Paulson moved to approve the October 6, 2022 minutes; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Cindy Schwehr moved to approve an Application for a Local Permit – Raffle from Hungry Pelican, contingent upon State’s Attorney review and approval; Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting “yes”.
